Mr. Drew,

After discussions with NC Division of Water Resources (NCDWR) and reviewing water sample analysis results for the above-referenced property, Guilford County Department of Health and Human Services (GCDHHS), Environmental Health Program, Water Quality Unit, recommends for this property to connect to the City of Greensboro water service. In addition to church functions, Tabernacle UMC also operates a daycare at this location. Per my discussion with Mr. Michael Gendy, P.E., NCDWR, pH fluctuations in the groundwater may contribute to leaching of lead and copper within the distribution system. Chemical stability in treated municipal water may reduce the leaching of lead and copper at this property.

NCDWR and GCDHHS agree that connecting this property to the Greensboro municipal water supply is a public necessity.
