The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted by the lowest bidder, Laughlin-Sutton Construction Company, to determine compliance with the City of Greensboro's M/WBE Plan. The contract goals established for the project were MBE 3% and WBE 5%; no bidder reached the goals. All bidders provided evidence of Good Faith Efforts to try to make the MBE and WBE goals.

Laughlin-Sutton Construction Company, the lowest bidder, proposed to commit \$4,350 or .7% of the total bid amount, \$649,000 to a MBE firm and \$15,560 or 2.4% to a WBE firm.

Laughlin-Sutton Construction Company has agreed to meet its M/WBE commitment utilizing the following certified firms:
