Outdoor Display and Storage

Outdoor Display and Storage

Requirements included with LDO (adopted 2010):


Ensure display and storage areas designed to prevent conflicts with:

- Site and emergency access
- Required parking areas
- Required planting yards

Requires enhanced screening when adjacent to residential zoning

Outdoor Display - directly accessible to public

Outdoor Storage - not accessible to public





Outdoor Display and Storage

Type A Outdoor Display

Applies to any district with retail uses
Display area subordinate to retail establishment
(no more than 15% of gross floor area of retail space)

Ex. Garden supplies, building supplies, etc.



Type B Outdoor Display

Applies to commercial and industrial zoning districts Display area is majority (at least 51% of retail space)

Ex. vehicle sales, manufactured home sales, etc.






Outdoor Display and Storage (Proposed Change)

Type B Outdoor Display

Adjust minimum threshold for Type B Outdoor Display to minimum 40% of total gross retail area.

Accommodates new retail models with significant indoor and outdoor retail areas






