Greensboro Aquatic Center West Elevation Expansion

The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted by the lowest bidder, Shelco, LLC to determine compliance with the City of Greensboro's M/WBE Plan and found that while it did not meet the M/WBE goals, the company made reasonable Good Faith Efforts to try to meet the goals. The goals established for the project were MBE 10% and WBE 11%. Shelco, LLC proposed to subcontract 8% of the contract dollars to WBE firms and 4% to an MBE firm. The M/WBE commitment was reduced because one of the firms proposed for participation did not meet the City's Significant Business Presence requirement.

Shelco, LLC agreed to meet its M/WBE commitment utilizing the following certified M/WBE firms:
