
Purpose








Phase I Recommendations



Preserve & Maintain Compatibility

- Mirror existing scale & form
- Encourage context sensitive conversions and appropriate infill
- Encourage a high level of property maintenance



Preserve & Enhance the Tree Canopy

- Conduct a street tree inventory along Lawndale Drive
- Complete a canopy management plan for the corridor
- Establish a 'remove & reforest' program to support canopy health



Enhance Non-Motorized Amenities

- Study 'spaghetti' junction to the south and the I-840 interchange to the north
- Complete the A & Y Greenway connection south
- Improve east-west connectivity, access & crossing visibility
