The Opportunity

- Key element in the redevelop of the Renaissance Shops at Phillips Avenue
 - 10,000 sq ft full-service, neighborhood grocery store with a wide range of healthy foods at affordable prices
- ➤ Thirty-one (31) new jobs, with benefits, in Northeast Greensboro
 - > 17 full-time jobs
 - > 14 part-time jobs
 - All jobs to pay \$10 per hour or more
- Will help address food disparity in an identified food desert in Northeast Greensboro



Economic Development Challenge Grant

- ➤ City of Greensboro will match **new** funds raised by the Renaissance Community Cooperative (RCC) up to \$250,000
- RCC must have obtained at least \$1,000,000, with funds 'in hand' or Letters of Commitment from identified supporters
 - May include grants, loans, or other sources
- RCC will continue to pursue funding support from Guilford County and other sources
- ➤ Within 6 months of receiving a certificate of occupancy, and for each \$50,000 of matching grant received, RCC must:
 - Create 1 new full-time job, with benefits
 - Must retain those jobs for at least 2 years



Economic Development Challenge Grant

- The Challenge Grant will be funded by:
 - Economic Development Fund \$200,000 in FY 15/16
 - Community Development Block Grant \$50,000 in FY 15/16
- RCC will be comply with all applicable requirements of the City of Greensboro Minority/Women Business Enterprise Program Plan for construction, professional services, goods, and other services
- ➤ The Challenge Grant will expire 1-year from approval by Greensboro City Council



Recommendation

- ➤ Consideration of a Resolution authorizing an economic development Challenge Grant not to exceed the amount of \$250,000.00 to Renaissance Community Cooperative
- ➤ Conditions of the public participation will be contained in a performance agreement between the City of Greensboro and Renaissance Community Cooperative
