Yes, HUD will accept requests submitted for the following actions during the CoC Program Registration process but not later than 5 days before the end of the CoC Program Registration Period:

- The merger of two or more CoCs' geographic areas;
- The separation of one or more geographic area(s) from a CoC's previously claimed geographic areas to be claimed by another CoC; or
- 3. The splitting of an existing CoC and the division of the previously claimed geographic areas into two or more CoCs.
