Allow residents appealing via PCRB to have a self-appointed advocate to walk them through the process. PCRB and Human Relations staff can serve in advocate/ambassador role, if requested

Review, Advise, Report, Recommend

# **Expanded Scope of PCRB**

#### **Recommendation:**

If a citizen complaint is reviewed by the PSD/PCRB and the result of the investigation finds that the officers or charges were not legally justified in the arrest, the City may seek a (1) dismissal of the charges and (2) expungement of any wrongful arrest.

- (1) City may request dismissal of charges. Final decision is at the discretion of the District Attorney
- (2) Expungement of records are subject to North Carolina State Law

# **Expanded Scope of PCRB**

#### Recommendation:

Council commitment to continue to educate, review and adjust rules and procedures of PCRB to reflect a fair and impartial process.

Quarterly reporting of PCRB to Council on activities and attendance.
