INFORMATION FOR THE PUBLIC

For safety purposes, all packages, handbags and briefcases will be visually inspected by security prior to individuals entering the Council Chambers.

- At hearings involving rezoning applications, proponents and opponents shall be provided a total of fifteen (15) minutes notwithstanding the number of persons desiring to be heard. Proponents shall be heard first followed by comments from opponents. Each side may speak a total of five (5) minutes rebuttal.
- Speakers who wish to speak to other agenda items will be allowed a maximum of three (3) minutes.
- Speakers who wish to speak on non-agenda items will be allowed a maximum of five (5) minutes at the first meeting of the month which will primarily be for ceremonial/presentation items, unlimited public comment, and items calling public hearings and will need to sign up PRIOR to 6:15 p.m. if they wish to speak. Speakers will be grouped together according to topic and called in the order in which they sign up for their specific topic.
- The second meeting of the month will primarily be for consent items, public hearings and business items; public comment will be limited to agenda items only.
- A closed session may be held at this meeting.
- The Council will consider all public hearing and business items listed on the agenda. If the meeting continues to 10:30 p.m., Council will adjourn the meeting after all agenda items have been considered; Council comments at the end of the meeting will not be heard. Council reserves the right to change the conduct of the meeting.
