Brief Project Summary The purpose of this project is to implement a convenience store recycling program in the City of Greensboro by purchasing (166) 30 gallon recycling containers and placing each container at the pump islands and next to the store's entrances. New containers will be purchased also for new customers as well as to maintain a replacement stock. The grant will include the purchase of informational materials such as brochures and posters which will serve to educate convenience store owners about the program.


This implementation of this program will increase awareness to recycling efforts which will gain more public participation and heighten recycling efforts in the community.
