RESOLUTION ORDERING THE MAKING OF CERTAIN LOCAL  
IMPROVEMENTS

CROSSWINDS COURT FROM AN EXISTING 8" LINE AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF CROSSWINDS COURT AND COVERED WAGON ROAD NORTHEAST TO  
5309 CROSSWINDS COURT

WHEREAS, due notice has been given that on the 17th day of February, 2009 at  
5:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber in the Municipal Office Building a public  
hearing would be held on the improvements hereinafter described and that all  
objections to the legality of the making of the improvements are required by law  
to be made in writing, signed in person or by attorney, and filed with the City  
Clerk at or before the time of the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing has now been held and no objections have been  
made to the making of the improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF GREENSBORO:

A. That the street or streets hereinabove set out is/are

SEWER LINE IMPROVEMENT ON CROSSWINDS COURT FROM AN  
EXISTING 8" LINE AT THE INTERSECTION OF CROSSWINDS COURT AND  
COVERED WAGON ROAD NORTHEAST TO 5309 CROSSWINDS COURT

B. That the local improvements to be made on the street or streets set out above  
are as follows:

(a) Sanitary Sewer Improvements. That a sanitary sewer main of 8-inch  
size be laid on the street or streets hereinabove named within the limits  
defined, and that necessary laterals (including water laterals where none  
exist and water main has been installed) be laid for the proper connection  
of abutting property.

C. That the proportion of the cost of the improvements to be assessed against  
the abutting property and the terms of payment will be as provided in the Notice  
of Public Hearing which was served on the owners of the property to be  
assessed.

D. That this resolution be published one time in a newspaper published in the  
City of Greensboro as notice of the matters herein set out.
