Raleigh

- Two regular council meetings per month
- Four Standing Committees
 - Budget & Economic Development Committee
 - Law and Public Safety Committee
 - Public Works Committee
 - Comprehensive Planning Committee
- Committees meet twice monthly
- Items are referred to committee from Council
- No items originate in committee
- Televised with formal minutes taken



Charlotte

- Council meets every Monday
- Seven Standing Committees
 - Community Safety
 - Housing & Neighborhood Development
 - Economic Development

- Transportation
- Environment
- Budget
- Governmental Affairs
- Committees meet once monthly or as needed
- Items are referred to committee from Council
- Considered Council focus areas
- Mayor appoints committees- 5 Council members
- Open to public but generally not open to public comment
- Not televised
- Summary minutes taken



Winston-Salem

- Two regular council meetings per month
 - First meeting- public hearing items
 - Second meeting- committee agenda items
- Four Standing Committees
 - Finance Committee
 - Public Safety Committee
 - Public Works Committee
 - Community Development and General Government Committee
- Four members appointed by council per committee
- Mayor serves as ex officio of all the committees
- Each has a chairperson and vice-chairperson
- Committees meet once monthly



Winston-Salem (continued)

- All agenda items except zoning items go to committee before regular council meeting
- All items without a negative vote from committee go on the consent agenda
- Televised with formal minutes taken
- Allows public comment on agenda items
- Consider and make recommendations to the city council on policy matters
- Hold public hearings on questions when requested to do so by the council
- In collaboration with the city manager, make special studies and submit reports to the council on matters falling within that committee's province



Greensboro

- Two regular council meetings per month
- Two work sessions per month
- Council Committees created as needed
- Two current active committees
 - East Greensboro Study Committee
 - Economic Development Committee
- Four members appointed by council per committee
- Each has a chairperson



- Greensboro- Possible Alternative
 - Two regular council meetings per month
 - First meeting- committee agenda items
 - Second meeting- public hearing items
 - Discontinue the two work sessions per month
 - Create four standing Council Committees
 - Align with MAP Result Areas
 - Community Services
 - General Government
 - Infrastructure
 - Public Safety
 - Three/four members appointed by council per committee
 - Each has a chairperson



- Greensboro- Possible Alternative
 - Each committee will review associated agenda items
 - Committees will receive Result Area Work Plans and updates
 - Examples per Result Area
 - Community Services
 - Parks & Recreation, Neighborhood Development, Library, and Human Relation issues
 - Housing code ordinance revisions
 - Nuisance ordinances
 - User fees
 - Policy revisions
 - Contracts
 - Capital Projects



- Greensboro- Possible Alternative
 - Examples per Result Area Continued
 - General Government
 - Finance, Budget, IT, HR, M/WBE and Executive issues
 - Contracts and purchase orders
 - Annual operating budget
 - Budget amendments
 - Annual financial reports
 - Purchase and sale of property
 - Fees
 - Policy revisions
 - Grants requiring a match
 - Capital Projects



- Greensboro- Possible Alternative
 - Examples per Result Area Continued
 - Infrastructure
 - E&I, Field Operations, Planning, Transportation, and Water Resources issues
 - Contracts
 - Budget review
 - Road & alley closures
 - Utility easements
 - Stormwater/Water issues
 - Roadway naming
 - Annexation petitions
 - Ordinance revisions
 - Fees
 - Capital Projects

 - Examples per Result Area Continued
 - Public Safety
 - Fire, GM 911, and Police issues
 - Contracts
 - Grant applications
 - Budget review
 - Ordinance revisions
 - Fees
 - Projects



- Greensboro- Possible Alternative
 - Other items to consider
 - Televise Council Committee meetings
 - Formal agendas/minutes
 - Speakers from the floor
 - Change Current Council Committees
 - Keep current committees and ability to create study committees
 - Change name to task force
 - More informal process than proposed Council Committees

 - Next Steps
 - Change City Code to include Council Committees
 - Educate/Advertise new process to public & staff
