## Five Different Types

- Autonomous Boards
- ABC- 5 members
- Greensboro Housing Authority- 7 members- all appointed by Mayor
- Piedmont Triad Regional Airport Authority- 7 members- 1 Council appointment
- Piedmont Triad Regional Water Authority- 10 members- 2 Council appointments
- Greensboro/Guilford County Tourism Development Authority- 13 members- 5 Council appointments
- Quasi-judicial Boards
- Greensboro Board of Adjustment- 7 members/2 alternates
- Greensboro Minimum Housing Standards Commission- 7 members
- Historic Preservation Commission- 9 members

## Five Different Types (continued)

- Administrative Boards
- Firemen's Relief Fund Board- 6 members- 2 Council appointments
- Firemen's Supplemental Retirement System Board- 5 members- 1 Council appointment
- John Motley Morehead Commission- 19 members- 3 Council appointments
- Legislative Boards
- County Joint Historic Properties Commission- 11 members- 3 Council appointments
- Planning Board- 9 members
- Redevelopment Commission- 5 members
- Zoning Commission-9 members


## Boards \& Commissions

Five Different Types (continued)

- Policy Making \& Advisory Boards
- Commission on the Status of Women- 15 members
- Human Relations Commission- 15 members
- Board of Trustees of the Greensboro Public Library- 11 members- 9 Council appointments
- Parks \& Recreation Commission- 9 members
- Greensboro Transit Authority- 9 members
- War Memorial Commission- 11 members- 2 non-voting


## Boards \& Commissions

- City Code mandates that the term of all appointed members of boards and commissions be 3 years
- Members must not serve more than 2 full terms without an intervening 1 year period
- Included in the Land Development Ordinance
- Planning Board, Zoning Commission, Board of Adjustment and Historic Preservation Commission
- State Law specifies term limits
- Board of Adjustment
- Historic Preservation Commission
- Appointment Process
- Appointments are made at every Council meeting
- Council places names into the databank
- Once in databank- appointment can be made at next meeting


## Boards \& Commissions

- Requested changes could focus on Policy Making \& Advisory Boards
- 9 required members
- Each district has representative
- 3 at-large representatives
- Mayor appoints one representative
- Current Boards \& Commissions with more than 9 members
- Mayor appoints remaining members
- Term Limits
- 2 Year Limits
- 3 consecutive terms


## Boards \& Commissions

- Additional Consideration
- Implementation of Proposed Changes
- Change term limits once current term expires
- Allows current members to complete service
- Staggered term limits
- Limits risk of full vacancy
- Limits loss of all knowledge at one time
- Council would need to formally adopt changes through resolution
