The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted by the lowest bidder, Jimmy R. Lynch & Sons, Inc. to determine compliance with the City's M/WBE Plan. The contract goals were MBE 7% and WBE 8%. Documentation submitted with the bid indicates Jimmy R. Lynch met the WBE goal and demonstrated adequate good faith efforts to try to meet the MBE goal. Of the total bid amount, \$13,576,830.81 the contractor proposed to commit \$1,088,071.12 or 8% to a certified WBE firms and \$688,394.50 or 5% to certified MBE firms.

Jimmy R. Lynch & Sons, Inc. has agreed to meet its M/WBE commitment utilizing the following certified firms:
