The Project - Qorvo

- RF Micro Devices, Inc. was founded in Greensboro in 1991 and has become a global leader in the design and manufacture of high-performance radio frequency solutions
- ➤ Over 1,400 employees in Greensboro area
- Merged with TriQuint Semiconductor, Inc. in January 2015





The Opportunity

- Construct a new 150,000 square foot Research and Development facility on their Thorndike Road campus
- Investment of \$25M in new building construction and equipment
 - \$19.5M in Real Property (building)
 - > \$5.5M in Machinery & Equipment
- Create 100 new jobs over a three-year period
- > Average salary \$80,000/yr plus benefits





Incentive Request

- Requesting incentives to assist with \$25 Million in real property capital costs and hiring of 100 new employees
- Requesting investment based incentive of \$544,279 paid out over 5 years (\$108,856/yr.)
- Incentive Grant to be recaptured through incremental ad valorem tax and sales tax impacts within 6 years
- ➤ Meets the minimum criteria in 3 of the 3 requirements of the Economic Incentive Guidelines and is in a targeted cluster Innovative Manufacturing

Economic Impact

> Based on:

- Creating 100 New Jobs over 3 years with an average salary of \$80,000.00/year not including benefits
- Investing \$25 million for new Research & Development facility on their Thorndike Road campus
- Encouraged to hire locally and to use local contractors/vendors





Recommendation – Consider A Performance-Based Incentive

> \$544,279 incentive grant paid out over five consecutive years after the full investment has been made and ad valorem taxes paid

AND

- New jobs have been created based on the hiring schedule provided
- Execution of Performance-Based ED Incentive Grant Agreement

- **Project:** New 150,000 SF Research & Development Center next to corporate offices
- Investment: \$25M investment
- Jobs: 100 New R&D analyst jobs at an average wage of \$80,000



Company Overview



- RF Micro Devices started in Greensboro in 1991 and has been a staple employer in the community for over 24 years
- RFMD merged with TriQuint Semiconductor on Jan 1, 2015 to create Qorvo
- Headquarters for the company are in Greensboro, North Carolina and Hillsboro, Oregon (home of TriQuint)
- Locations in Guilford County:
 - HQ on Thorndike Rd, Greensboro
 - NC Design Center at 4050 Premier Dr, High Point
- Current employment in Greensboro is approximately 1,429
 - 860 employees live in Guilford County, or 60% of the workforce

- 100 New R&D analyst jobs
- Average wage of \$80,000
- Significant benefits package for employees worth 25% over and above salary
 - Comprehensive medical, dental and vision plans, and wellness programs
 - Life and Disability Insurance
 - 401(k) savings plan & Employee Stock Purchase Plan
 - Tuition Reimbursement Program
