Brief Project Summary

City of Greensboro - Recycling Drop Site Improvements/Public School ...

This grant will cover two (2) proposed projects: 1)The City of Greensboro currently operates 20 unmanned drop sites for commingled recyclables but has identified 3 city-owned properties (fire stations) that would be suitable for new drop site placement to fill gaps in coverage. We would like to place two 8-yard dumpsters at each of these locations. 2) The City of Greensboro has taken over collections for Guilford County Schools and as a result the needs of our schools have been reevaluated. All Greensboro located Guilford County schools have at one (1) commingled recycling dumpster and it is our goal along with providing infrastructure and educations to these schools, to also purchase recycling receptacles to be placed in the classroom in all participating schools. They will be free of charge provided that the schools agree to the written parameters.

Goals, Strategies, Objectives supported

Goal Project #1: Using GIS we were able to identify which areas of the city were more or less distant from the existing unmanned recycling drop sites. We then identified three (3) city-owned properties (fire stations) that would be suitable for new drop site placement to fill gaps in coverage. We would like to place two 8-yard dumpsters at each of these locations. We will measure the effectiveness of this project by randomly surveying the new drop sites to assess the level to which they are utilized.

Goal Project #2: Currently most classrooms in our schools do not have recycling containers. However, each school within the City of Greensboro has at least one (1) recycling commingled dumpster. The goal of this project is to reach as many schools as possible in the first grant round, and to continue this project under the city's purview until all Guilford County Schools have proper recycling access.
