RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF MAY AS NATIONAL LUPUS MONTH

WHEREAS, over forty thousand North Carolinians are affected by Lupus;

WHEREAS, Lupus is an unpredictable and misunderstood autoimmune disease that ravages different parts of the body;

WHEREAS, the disease is challenging to treat and can cause seizures, strokes, heart attacks, miscarriages and organ failure;

WHEREAS, the diagnosis of Lupus is difficult as its symptoms are similar to those of many other illnesses and gaps exist in understanding the causes and consequences of the disease;

WHEREAS, Lupus strikes mostly women of childbearing age but can impact anyone;

WHEREAS, African Americans, Hispanics/Latinos, Asians and Native Americans are two to three times more likely to develop Lupus;

WHEREAS, the Lupus Foundation of America designates May as National Lupus Awareness Month to show support for millions of Americans who have Lupus;

WHEREAS, Beautiful Butterflies is a local non-profit organization that provides education and support for Lupus patients, caregivers, family members and friends;

WHEREAS, the citizens of Greensboro are urged to educate themselves on the symptoms and impact of Lupus as well as support programs of research, education and community service.
