 - Rehabilitation of existing rental housing units
 - Conversion of non-residential buildings to rental housing use
- \$300,000 HOME RFP funds set aside for LIHTC project awards

Request for Proposals issued February 11

- 3 proposals received for City competitive funds
- 3 proposals received for LIHTC set-aside funds

- Visited each site
- Evaluated 3 applications for City competitive funds

March 16 Planning Board Recommendation:

 Fund 2 projects with available RFP funds plus reallocation of \$150,000 in Single Family Development funds

May 2016

August 2016

- Projects that received an award will be evaluated for the \$300,000 HOME set aside

October 2016

 Planning Board will make recommendation to City Council on the \$300,000 set aside for LIHTC projects
