ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-90 OF THE GREENSBORO CODE OF ORDINANCES

Section 1. That Section 2-90 of the Greensboro Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-90. - Authority of the city manager to execute service contracts and of the city attorney to approve legal service contracts.

The city manager, and his designees shall have the authority to approve service contracts in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) and less, and the authority to approve service contracts related to capital projects, joint participation agreements with State agencies, and financial transactions related to approved debt financing in the amount of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and less on behalf of the city, and the city attorney shall have the authority to approve all legal service contracts, provided that city council shall have approved a sufficient appropriation in the annual budget for the current fiscal years. In the event of a special emergency involving the health and safety of the people or their property, the manager may contract for amounts in excess of his authority, provided he notify council as soon as practical, and place the contract on the next agenda for review and ratification.

Section 2. That all contracts entered into prior to this amendment remain fully in force.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
