Grant/Project Name	BJA's Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program		
Brief Project Summary	In 2012, the Greensboro Police Department (GPD) self-initiated its pilot BWC program. Those efforts outfitted one-half of its Patrol Bureau. The purchase of the equipment was only limited by funding; the challenge was in the creation & implementation of policy & the issue of public release. Upon the program's creation, the Greensboro program had no policy with which to guide them & policy available elsewhere in the country to model was limited. Moreover, NC Statutes were & continue to be nebulous as to what is available for public release. The GPD wishes to re-launch its BWC program, based on the tremendous experience it has gained in many arenas. The re-launch includes replacing current equipment & expanding BWC usage. Furthermore, the department wishes to expand its progra to cover more policing areas, such officers working secondary employment, to rookies in field training for immediate review & feedback, to certain investigative units & to all officers in the Pati Bureau so each officer has his/her own equipment with an expan life span. Subsequently, the department would like to lead the wain crafting departmental policy that would support & adhere to ar legislation facilitating review of BWC recordings.		
	Anticipated outcomes include issuing guidance & training to the officers to ensure their competency using the new equipment & in understanding the policies. New policy would include the areas of secondary employment & investigative units. The department will continue its performance metrics, such as monitoring citizen complaints & uses of force.
