RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF CONTRACT NO. 2012-5485 WITH  
REPUBLIC SERVICES, INC. FOR MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2012, City Council approved a contract with Republic Services, Inc. for municipal solid waste disposal services from the City's Burnt Poplar Road transfer station to the Republic's Uwharrie Environmental Landfill in Montgomery County, North Carolina;

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2014-14 the cost of hauling approximately 202,000 tons of municipal solid waste from the transfer station was about \$4,600,000;


WHEREAS, the contract was to have an initial three-year term with the option of two additional one-year extensions;

WHEREAS, this contract extension is the first of two available one-year extensions at an estimated cost of \$4,700,000 and has the support of the Greensboro Solid Waste Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
GREENSBORO AND REPUBLIC SERVICES OF NORTH CAROLINA, LLC.**

This Second Amendment is entered into the 13<sup>th</sup> day of ~~September~~ <sup>November</sup>, 2015 between the City of Greensboro (the "City") and Republic Services of North Carolina, LLC, (the "Company") to amend the agreement for the provision of municipal solid waste disposal services between the parties dated as of the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2012.

This Agreement between the City of Greensboro and Republic Services of North Carolina, LLC that was entered into on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2012 was amended on 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 2012 in the First Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Greensboro and Republic Services of North Carolina, LLC.

The parties agree that the term of the Agreement and the First Amendment to the Agreement is extended from the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015 to the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016.

The parties agree that unless specifically modified herein, the terms of the Agreement and First Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Greensboro and Republic Services of North Carolina LLC, remain in full force and effect.

In the event of any conflict, inconsistency, or incongruity between the provisions of this Second Amendment shall in all respects govern and control.
