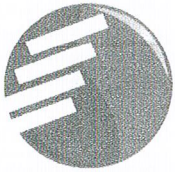

- Reposition transmitter to highest point in the water box
- Gently open up shut off valve assuring meter is in operation


