Goals of the Board provided by Council Resolution

 - annual application process
 - annual financial audit requirements
 - performance
- \circ $\,$ Broaden access and awareness to the process $\,$
- Involve both community and staff in evaluation process
- Process based on a fixed allocation of resources and included in the Manager's proposed budget
- Available funding \$900,000
- Board recommendation process used since FY 16-17



Application Process FY 18-19

- November 1
 - Application and Website Available
 - News Release about Process
- November 9
 - Community Partner Funding Process Kickoff Session
- December 5
 - Technical Workshops to assist potential partners with application completion
- December 22
 - Deadline for <u>ALL</u> application materials



Application Process FY 18-19

- January through February
 - Initial Staff Review for Completeness
 - Community Partners Board Application Review
 - \circ In-person Interviews with selected requestors
- April 9
 - Community Partners Board Recommendation to City Manager
- May 15
 - Recommendations from City Manager to the City Council for consideration
- June 19
 - Final funding determined by City Council through Budget Adoption
