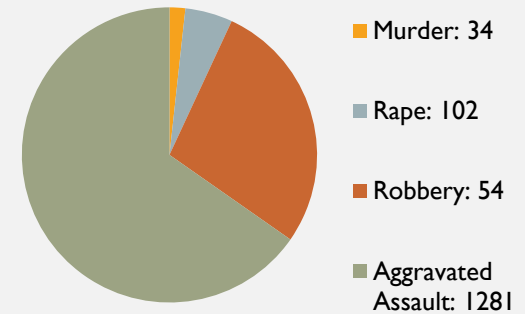

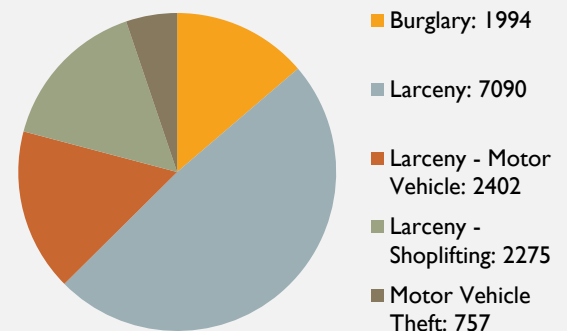

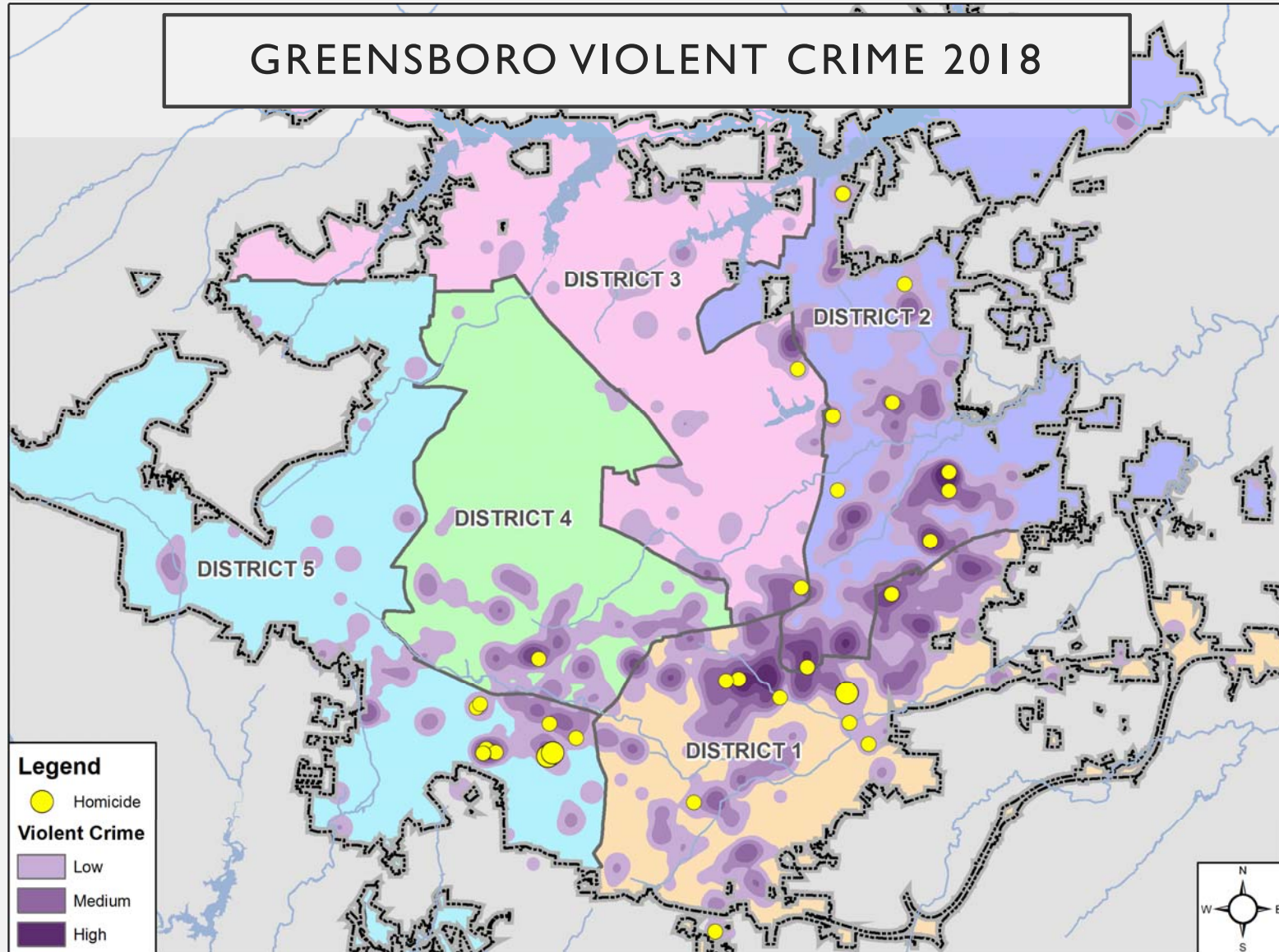

\$128,709 = Value of Property Recovered

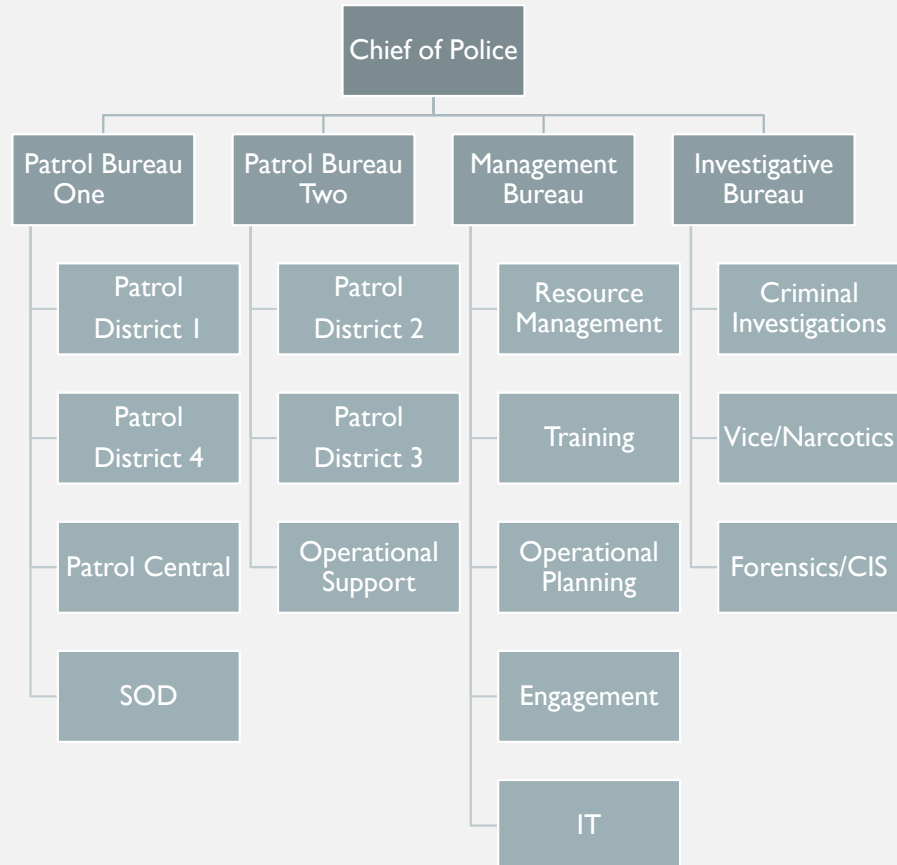
Hot Spot Policing:

Focusing on area where there are more victims.

- Hours Spent: 766 patrolling
- Overtime cost est: \$33,700
- Violent Crime Initiative
 - Partner with Federal and state prosecutors
- Changes to Patrol
 - Focus on Crime
 - Better Balance of resources

SAFER CITY SUMMIT COMMUNITY RESPONSE 2018

2017

- Launched to engage organizations from across the city delve into the underlying issues that lead to violent crime.
- 5 community led working groups:
 - Public Safety
 - Youth Outreach and Services
 - Housing
 - Employment
 - Legislative Concerns: Legal issues, State Statues
- **Successes include:** Job fair, new community contacts, youth outreach, information sharing

2018

Combined groups based on goals

- Employment, Housing and Youth
- New Group: Gangs

Housing: lead by community volunteers (over 15 meetings attended; multiple community training for potential leaders; new relationships in hot spot communities)

- Project Safe Neighborhood Grant
 - 2 pronged approach – Police and partners
 - Gangs Working group addition
- Job Fairs: Fall Job Fair focused on Re-entry, Made2 Rise
- Youth: Outreach with Houses of Worship



SAFER CITY GREENSBORO 2019

Community:

- Housing: Will continue with community meetings and listening tour lead by community volunteers, will offer community training for potential leaders;
 - Relaunch of Community Watch: Feb 2019
- Project Safe Neighborhood Grant
 - New partners in the non-profit community
- Job Fairs: January 2019 job fairs with 24 agencies and 70 reps attendees in total for the general public lead by partner Made2rise
