

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTRAL CAROLINA HEALTH  
NETWORK FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR  
PERSONS WITH AIDS GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro is the grantee for the federal Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS [HOPWA] program grant serving Guilford, Randolph, and Rockingham Counties;

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina issued a Request for Applications for HIV Patient Management Model Networks of Care asking for regional HIV/AIDS services agencies to align themselves in a services network under one administrative organization for HIV/AIDS pass through funding;

WHEREAS, Central Carolina Health Network was selected by the state as the Project Sponsor for the Region 4 network of HIV/AIDS services agencies through fiscal year 2020;

WHEREAS, it is in the City's interest to maintain the collaborative network model established by the State of North Carolina and utilize Central Carolina Health Network as the Project Sponsor in the network administrator role for the HOPWA funds for fiscal year 2020;

WHEREAS, City Council is requested to approve a professional services agreement with Central Carolina Health Network for \$419,625 in HOPWA grant funds, with administration limited to 7 percent of the grant and with a contract start date of October 1, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services agreement with Central Carolina Health Network for \$419,625 in Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS [HOPWA] grant funds.
