

RESOLUTION TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING ON DECEMBER 17, 2019 TO RECEIVE PUBLIC
COMMENTS ON AN APPLICATION FOR THE 2019 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,102

WHEREAS, in accordance with public safety funding federal regulation, 42 U.S.C. § 3751(a), the City of Greensboro wishes to apply for a formula based grant allocation through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG), CFDA#16.738;

WHEREAS, the City is required to conduct a public hearing for the governing body to consider public input in a decision authorizing grant application and a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Greensboro, City of High Point, and Guilford County that reflects agreement on the allocations;

WHEREAS, the Greensboro Police Department, High Point Police Department and Guilford County Sheriff's Department will propose the following grant allocation based on the grant solicitation requirements and formula that allows Cities to receive a higher allocation than Counties, even when Counties have the greater financial obligation;

WHEREAS, the allocation totals \$250,102 and the planned application amounts for each jurisdiction are:

- Guilford County: \$ 61,034.80
- City of Greensboro: \$ 138,075.20
- City of High Point: \$ 50,992.00;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro's Police Department plans to serve as the lead/fiscal agent for the grant in FY 2019; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That the request to conduct a public hearing for December 17, 2019 to receive public comments on the proposed 2019 Justice Assistance Grant application in the total amount of \$250,102 to be divided between the Greensboro Police Department (\$138,075.20); Guilford County Sheriff's Department (\$61,034.80); and the High Point Police Department (\$50,992).
