SUBJECT: Coliseum Complex & Tanger Center NorthState Contract Expansion

The M/WBE Office reviewed the request from the Coliseum to amend the current contract (2019-5217) for Wifi Service with NorthState Communications. The original agreement awarded to NorthState Communications for a fifty-nine month term for a total contract value up to \$1,818,960. The construction of the new Tanger Center requires an expansion of this service to cover both the Coliseum Complex and the Tanger Center. The new contract amount will increase to \$2,288, 010. The M/WBE office and the Program Plan supports the request to increase the contract.

The M/WBE Office supports the upgrade and extension of services for the remainder of the contract through December 2024 (59 months) until the services are eligible to be rebid. To change services at this time would be deemed as infeasible and impractical because it would create a gap in city services.

SUBJECT: Coliseum Complex & Tanger Center Handheld Radio Lease Expansion

The M/WBE Office reviewed the request from the Coliseum to amend the current lease contract (2019-5025) for handheld radios with Mobile Communications, Inc. The original agreement awarded to Mobile Communications for a five-year term and with a marketing trade value per year of \$2,000, increasing the total contract to \$68,000. The construction of the new Tanger Center requires an expansion of this service to cover both the Coliseum Complex and the Tanger Center. The new contract amount will increase to \$96,075. M/WBE office and the Program Plan supports the request to increase the contract.

The M/WBE Office supports the upgrade and extension of services for the remainder of the contract through December 2023 (48 months) until the services are eligible to be rebid. To change services at this time would be deemed as infeasible and impractical because it would create a gap in city services.
