Agreement

The M/WBE Office reviewed the request and documentation submitted for the water and sewer services needed for the renovation of the old Camp Burton site to the new Army Reserve Center to determine compliance with the City of Greensboro M/WBE Program Plan.

Freese and Nichols, Inc., an non-M/WBE firm was selected by the Water Resources Department to provide the above services. The vendor was requested to solicit and make an effort to use certified M/WBE firms capable of providing services needed to fulfill the supplemental agreement. The vendor committed to utilizing M/WBE firms for the project.

The Contractor commits to subcontract MBE 24.39% (\$579,885) and WBE 18.64% (\$443,000) of the total contract value of \$2,377,160 to the following M/WBE firms.
