Recommendation for Local Historic Landmark Designation

Property: Weaver-Sherwin Building, 603 South Elm Street (Parcel # 477)

Property designation details: The Guilford County Historic Preservation Commission recommends to the Greensboro City Council that the property noted above be designated as a Local Historic Landmark property. The designation includes the entire exterior of the building and the following interior components: all original wood flooring upstairs and downstairs, skylights, and the front, central stairwell, not including handrails.

Motion to recommend: Following review and discussion of the application at the regular Guilford County Historic Preservation Commissioner meeting on February 18, 2020, Commission Member Dowell made a motion to recommend **approval** for Local Historic Landmark designation. Commission Member Hammond seconded the motion. The Historic Preservation Commissioners voted 6-0 to approve the motion.
