FY 20-21 Recommended Budget Mid-year Budget Monitoring and Adjustment

Budget Monitoring – "Mileposts and Triggers"

- Continuous monitoring of expenditures and revenues
 - Review of departmental financials on a monthly basis
 - Consumer analytics data to inform sales tax impacts
- Mileposts
 - Aug. 31 deadline for property tax discount
 - Sept. 15 final sales tax for FY 19-20
 - Late summer potential impacts on state shared revenues

Mid-year Adjustments – "Levers"

- Continued expenditure controls
 - Modified hiring freeze
 - Travel restrictions
- Review all expenditures for remainder of FY 20-21
 - Delayed compensation changes
 - Additional operational changes



FY 20-21 Recommended Budget Projected Revenue Updates

Property Taxes

- Revised projection for FY 20-21 of \$163,363,900
 - Increase of \$1,620,900
- Assessed value projection increase
 - 1.48% to 1.87%
- Updated revenue projections for assessed value from Guilford County

ABC Distribution

- Revised revenue projection of \$5,000,000
 - Increase of \$624,000
- Updated revenue projections based on revenues to date CY and revised projections on ABC use of working capital appropriations

FY 20-21 Recommended Budget Projected Revenue Updates

Fire District

- Revised projections of \$1,164,141
 - Decrease of \$191,393
- Updated revenue projections for property and sales tax distribution from Guilford County

Registered Motor Vehicle Property Taxes

- Revised projections of \$14,001,000
 - Decrease of \$737,000
- Updated revenue projections decrease due to anticipated impact on new vehicle registrations and delayed collections

Fund Balance

- Revised projection approximately \$4 million
 - Decrease of approximately \$700,000
- Decrease based on continued priority of limiting use of fund balance and strengthening financial sustainability

FY 20-21 Recommended Budget User Fee Changes

Field Operations

- Commercial Dumpster Rental \$50 monthly = \$20,400
 - Provides dumpster rental for commercial customers
- Future fee revisions being reviewed for cost recovery goals
 - Commercial recycling
 - Transfer station

FY 20-21 Recommended Budget General Fund Expenditure Changes

Police

- \$78.6 million budget
 - \$215,042, or 0.3% increase
 - 1 FTE decrease related to a reorganization
 - M&O increases \$88,768, or 0.7% related primarily to vehicle leases

Community Services

- \$41,634,001 million budget
 - Decrease of \$478,724, or 1.1%
 - Hotel/Motel Occupancy decreases \$1.15 million
- Neighborhood Development M&O decreases \$55,000 due to elimination of one-time study costs
- P&R increases \$693,000 primarily due to minimum wage increases
- Service area program reductions of approximately \$385,000
 - include reduced hours and limited services at P&R and Library facilities

FY 20-21 Recommended Budget Transit Fund (GTA)

CARES Funding

- \$12.4 million awarded through revised FTA disbursement process
 - Eligible Uses
 - Operations, safety and sanitation, capital investments
- Applying for additional disbursement
 - Timeline for revenue receipt anticipated in Fall 2020
- Anticipate \$8.4 million for FY 19-20 expenses
 - Remainder, approximately \$4 million used for FY 20-21 operations costs
