The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted by Kiewit Infrastructure South Co. to determine compliance with the City of Greensboro's M/WBE Program Plan. The contract goals established for the project were MBE 10% and WBE 9%. Documentation submitted with the bid indicates Kiewit Infrastructure South Co. met the established M/WBE Goals.

The appendices submitted with the bid package indicate that the bidder will expend \$805,780.00 or 29.71% of the total contract dollars, \$2,711,935.00 to M/WBE firms. A total of \$320,780.00 or 11.83% of the total contract dollars will be awarded to a MBE firm and \$485,000.00 or 17.88% of the total contract dollars will be awarded to a WBE firm.

Kiewit Infrastructure South Co. has proposed to meet its M/WBE commitment utilizing the following certified firms:
