

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING GREENSBORO POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICY
AMENDMENT RELATED TO CONSENT TO SEARCH PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the Greensboro City Council called upon the Greensboro Criminal Justice Advisory Commission (GCJAC) to survey the GPD Policy 12.5.1 (Consent Searches), and to consider whether to recommend changes to that policy;

WHEREAS, the Greensboro Criminal Justice Advisory Commission (GCJAC) surveyed the GPD Policy 12.5.1 (Consent Searches) and returned recommendations to amend the GPD current policies as edited on Policy 12.5.1;

WHEREAS, the Greensboro City Council called upon the Greensboro Police Department (GPD) to consider the changes recommended by the GCJAC, to review the Consent to Search policy, and to consider whether additional policy modifications would be warranted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That the Greensboro City Council recognizes and commends the Greensboro Police Department for its policy amendments related to Consent to Search procedures as edited in Policy 12.5.1 of the Greensboro Police Department Directives Manual.
