The M/WBE Office reviewed the change order request for Contract 2018-0370 - East Gate City Blvd Roadway and Sidewalk Improvements for the Transportation Department to determine continued compliance with the City's M/WBE Program Plan. The contractor is required to maintain the M/WBE participation throughout the duration of the contract unless approved in advance by the City.

The original M/WBE commitment was 10%. Change Order #1 for \$37,500.00, will increase the value of the contract from \$290,000.00 to \$327,500.00. The overall M/WBE utilization will increase to 10.68% with MBE 8.24% (\$27,000.00) and WBE 2.44% (\$8,000.00).
