#### Goals of the Action Plan

- Increase the supply of decent affordable housing
- Promote a suitable living environment
- Expand economic opportunities



## **Approval Process**

- Annual Action Plan is required to receive federal grant funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development [HUD]
- Projects address priorities approved in the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and honor long term commitments such as redevelopment plans and activities
- HUD announced FY 2021 allocation amounts in March 2021
- Plan adoption process:
  - ➤ April 5, 2021 Public comment period open through May 4
  - ➤ May 4, 2021 City Council considers recommendations
  - ➤ May 15, 2021 Plan must be submitted to HUD

Housing assistance and supportive services for low income persons with HIV/AIDS and their families in 3 counties: Guilford, Randolph, and Rockingham.


