

Access GSO History




Access GSO Snapshot

- 38% of \$24 million transit budget FY 21
- 57 Paratransit vehicles
- 2,743 Certified clients
 - 2,463 in ADA service area
 - 280 in Premium service area

Overarching Transit Goals

Council Goal

Increase by 20% the number of people that can reach place of employment without use of a personal vehicle by 2023

Increase ridership and improve public mobility.

Define transit's role in community mobility and economic development.

Makes Greensboro a great place to get around




Why Change? Why Now?

- Uncertainty in Federal, State transit funding
- Duke Power settlement funding ends 2027
- Since 2007: Paratransit operating costs doubled

- Actual trip cost:
 - Fixed Route: \$4.13
 - Paratransit: \$31.00
- Current fare recovery:
 - Fixed Route: 36%
 - Paratransit: 4%


Paratransit Ridership Trend








Paratransit Cost Trend

Paratransit Operation Insights

- FTA requires 'Comparable Level of Service' to Fixed Route (length of time, service area)
 - Current paratransit trip length is excessive vs. FR
 - FY 20 average: 8.93 miles, more than 1 hour travel time
- Certification considers both passenger ability and the accessibility of origin and destination

Paratransit Operation Insights

- Since FY 07: Paratransit +23%; Fixed route -26%
- Serves 0.9% of Greensboro population
- Access GSO vs. national peers:
 - Highest % population served
 - Highest % of transit budget
 - Average paratransit trip length and time: 3x median
 - Paratransit operating hours: 2x peer median

What We Heard: **Public Comment Sessions**

- Sessions May 5, 11 & 17
- Received comments by email, phone, text
- Petition from Industries of the Blind clients (92)

- Generally:
 - Support for incremental approach
 - Prefer no fare increase or to be fare free
 - Prefer equal fare for Fixed Route and Paratransit

Staff Recommendation

Multi-year fare increase

- \$2.00 ADA/Premium 1/2022
- \$2.50 ADA/Premium 1/2023
- \$3.00 ADA/Premium 1/2024
- 2025-2030: regular annual increase for premium trips to reach I-Ride contract rate

10 Ride Pass

- 1/2022	\$16.00
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- -1/2023\$18.00
- -1/2024\$20.00

40 Ride Pass

- -1/2022\$52.00
- -1/2023\$56.00
- -1/2024\$60.00

Staff Recommendation

- Service change 1/2022
 - Transition premium trips to I-Ride at Access GSO fare
- Implement ADA Operational Analysis Recommendations
 - Program refinements
 - Policy updates
- Partner with County
