Meeting Minutes - Final City Council Work Session

Tuesday, March 2, 2021 3:30 PM VIRTUAL

I. Call To Order

This virtual City Council work session of the City of Greensboro was called to order at 3:30 p.m. on the above date.

Mayor Vaughan took a roll call to confirm Councilmembers in attendance. The following members were present:

Mayor Nancy Vaughan, Councilmembers Marikay Abuzuaiter, Sharon Hightower, Nancy Hoffmann, Justin Outling, Tammi Thurm, and Goldie Wells.

Absent: Mayor Pro-Tem Yvonne Johnson and Councilmember Michelle Kennedy.

Also present were City Manager David Parrish, City Attorney Chuck Watts and Assistant City Clerk, Victoria L. Howell.

II. Presentations

1. ID 21-0183 Way Finding Update

Taking the prerogative of the Chair Mayor Vaughan stated Council would hear Item #2/ID 21-0184 prior to item #1/ID 21-0183 to accommodate the schedule of Michele Clark-Jenkins, Senior Director, Consulting Group for Griffin and Strong, P.C.

2. <u>ID 21-0184</u> Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Program Review/Griffin and Strong

Assistant City Manager Kim Sowell made a PowerPoint presentation (PPP); spoke to Minority/ Women Business Enterprise M/WBE utilization; to construction; to COVID-19 impacts; to professional services; to achieving goals; to vendors and contractors; to goods; to department M/WBE liaisons; and to Procurement card purchases.

Senior Director, Consulting Group for Griffin & Strong, P.C., Michele Clark-Jenkins spoke to weekly training meetings; to utilizing tools; to the need for professional services goals; to small business biding; to on-call contracts; to utilizing the database; and to COVID-19 impacts.

Discussion took place regarding North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) contracts; and to attainable professional service goals.

Councilmember Thurm requested staff to provide quarterly M/WBE updates with previous year comparisons; policy and standards for forecasting; particulars on tools and plans; tracking program progress; and engagement and mentorship from Griffin and Strong, P.C.

Ms. Clark-Jenkins spoke to data reform tracking; to setting goals; to sub-contracting; to monitoring and controlling; to outreach and supportive services; to forecasting in advance; and to tracking subcontractors.

Discussion ensued regarding virtual workshops; Piedmont Business Capital training; standard curriculum and trainings; joint ventures; and B2G software.
