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PURPOSE:

The attached ordinances serve to adopt the FY 16-17 annual operating budgets for the City of Greensboro for FY 16-17 grants and capital projects funds. A budget amendment needs to be approved by City Council to establish this budget.

BACKGROUND:

12. Capital project ordinance amending the Technical Services Capital Projects Fund.
13. Capital project ordinance amending the Solid Waste Capital Reserve Fund.
