**PURPOSE:**

An ordinance needs to be approved to appropriate funds associated with the sidewalk funding agreement with UNCG.

**BACKGROUND:**

UNCG requested sidewalk improvements to Neal Street to improve pedestrian mobility, accessibility, and safety, while connecting neighborhoods and protecting the environment. The sidewalk will also provide a means for staff to safely walk to and from their offices and assigned parking lots. UNCG agreed to reimburse the City for a portion of the costs.

This agreement specifies that the amount UNCG will reimburse the City is a not-to-exceed amount of \$35,066. The total project cost is \$70,943 which is being paid from 2008 Bond Funds.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funding in the amount of \$35,066 will be appropriated in the 2008 bond fund account 471-4502-15 to reimburse expenditures for this project.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Transportation Department recommends and requests approval of the attached ordinance associated with the sidewalk funding agreement with UNCG.
