PURPOSE: To honor The Armed Forces Retiree's Club (AFRC) scholarship recipient GYC Chairperson, Sarah Smith.

BACKGROUND: The Armed Forces Retiree's Club (AFRC) has chosen to sponsor a scholarship to be presented to a senior member of the Greensboro Youth Council (GYC). The scholarship is open to those seniors that have:

She is also active in band, student government and Girl Scouts. She will attend UNC Chapel Hill this fall to study business. She has received the gold level Presidential Services award and was a Parks Scholar finalist.
