PURPOSE:

Through their Local Giving Program, Wal-Mart stores, Sam's Clubs and Logistics facilities support the needs of their communities by providing grants to local organizations. The Wal-Mart Foundation has awarded the Greensboro Police Department a grant of \$1,000 for community outreach efforts with youth, adults and senior residents in Police Patrol District 3.
