**PURPOSE:**

Mayor Vaughan has requested a resolution requesting the State Department of Transportation to rename a portion of the Greensboro Urban Loop from the section of 1840 in the City of Greensboro from Bryan Boulevard to Battleground Avenue to the J. Douglas Galyon Freeway.

**BACKGROUND:**

J. Douglas Galyon has been a resident of the City of Greensboro since 1943 and is a 1948 graduate of Greensboro Senior High School.
