PURPOSE:

Through previous agreements, the City of Greensboro's Parks and Recreation Department has a history of use of the Guilford County Schools-owned property at 3701 Parkwood Drive, Greensboro, formerly the site of Craven Elementary School. The property features an open space area that is maintained by the City and is used for patron parking for the Greensboro Arboretum, located across the street at 401 Ashland Drive, Greensboro. Council approval of this agenda item and accompanying resolution and agreement will allow for the current arrangement to continue.

BACKGROUND:
