For over 85 years, the Greensboro Parks and Recreation Department has been serving the city by providing desirable and diverse parks, facilities, and programs. Since its inception, the Department has established itself as not only an integral part of the Greensboro's quality of life and economic viability, but also as an industry leader in being innovative, collaborative, and efficient towards meeting community recreational needs. The Department's vision, "Enhance Expand Connect," is a direct reflection of the City's commitment of providing high quality parks, programs, and facilities that makes Greensboro the best place to be.

Through the support of the City Council, Parks and Recreation Commission, community partners and dedicated professionals, Greensboro Parks and Recreation provides progressive leadership, and develops and maintains strong partnerships with public and private organizations to literally and figuratively change the landscape of

The department is one of 169 parks and recreation agencies in the country accredited by the Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation (CAPRA) and is also a three-time winner and 2019 finalist for the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) Gold Medal Award for excellence in park and recreation management. Additionally, a number of employees within the Department are considered subject matter experts in the recreation field, receiving awards and recognition and serving as a presenter at state and national conferences

To celebrate Parks and Recreation Month, the department has planned many activities to showcase the depth and breadth of opportunities available, including an Adult Recess and Trails Day community events.
