#### **PURPOSE:**

A budget ordinance is needed to increase the budget for amended agreement #4 with NCDOT for the Battleground-Benjamin-Cone Intersection Improvements Project (U-5306A).

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Project U-5306A, currently in the process of being closed out, reconstructed the Battleground Avenue / Benjamin Parkway / Cone Boulevard intersection to improve traffic flow and safety and to provide sidewalks and pedestrian crossing facilities. NCDOT originally agreed to reimburse the City for 100% of eligible project costs after the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) submitted it for consideration under the *Strategic Transportation Investments* prioritization process. City Council approved execution of the initial municipal agreement in 2011. NCDOT has agreed to increase its funding commitment at this time upon a review final expenditures prior to close-out of the project.
