#### **PURPOSE**:

City Council approval is requested to authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a contract with Educational Data Systems, Inc (EDSI) in an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 to fund Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Youth services through June 30, 2021.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Workforce Development Board/City of Greensboro issued an RFP to procure Youth Services in the Guilford County NCWorks Career Centers for Fiscal Year 2020-21.

On April 2, 2020, the Workforce Development Board voted to approve a contract with EDSI through June 30, 2021 at a cost not to exceed \$1,200,000 for the period of July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021.
