**PURPOSE:**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded supplemental funding through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) that requires programming in the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Action Plan includes the following Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) allocation and program funding awarded through the CARES Act:

**ESG-CV Funding for the City of Greensboro (\$675,621)**

**Proposed Uses of ESG-CV Funds:**

Rapid Rehousing: \$675,621
