PURPOSE:

Allocations are for workforce programs administered by the City of Greensboro's Workforce Development Department. A budget amendment needs to be approved to allow the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND:

1. Includes Detail Section 1 in Attachment A. The NC Department of Commerce provides a share of funding for infrastructure costs for the NCWorks Career Centers as of 1/01/2018. Based on the current statewide infrastructure agreement, the Guilford WDB has been granted funds in the amount of \$324,975 effective 12/4/2020 expiring 6/30/2021.

The Guilford WDB 2020 Infrastructure Fund is created in the amount of \$324,975.

2. Includes Detail Section 2 in Attachment A. The NC Department of Commerce provides business services funds to local WDBs based on request. The Guilford WDB has been granted funds in the amount of \$50,000 effective 12/4/2020, expiring 6/30/2021.

The Guilford WDB 2020 Business Services Fund is increased in the amount of \$50,000.
