#### PURPOSE:

Barry Siegal on behalf of Catherine and Dennis Torney requesting original zoning from **County RS-40** (Residential Single-Family) and **County AG** (Agricultural) to **City R-3** (Residential Single Family) for property located at 2732-ZZ Pleasant Ridge Road, generally described as south of Pleasant Ridge Road and east of Highland Grove Drive.

As this request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **May 17, 2016** meeting.

# **BACKGROUND:**

Following a public hearing on April 18, 2016, the Zoning Commission voted 9-0 to recommend approval of this request. One person spoke in favor of the request and none in opposition.
