PURPOSE:

The attached ordinances serve to adopt the FY 17-18 annual operating budgets for the City of Greensboro for FY 17-18 grants and capital projects funds. A budget amendment needs to be approved by City Council to establish this budget.

BACKGROUND:

- 10. Capital project ordinance amending the Solid Waste Capital Reserve Fund
