PURPOSE:

The attached ordinances serve to adopt the FY 17-18 annual operating budgets for the City of Greensboro for FY 17-18 grants and capital projects funds. A budget amendment needs to be approved by City Council to establish this budget.

BACKGROUND:

The following agenda items are associated with the adoption of the FY 17-18 Annual Budget. These ordinances and resolutions reflect changes discussed with Council during budget work sessions and include the following:

9. Capital project ordinance amending the Technical Services Capital Projects Fund.
10. Capital project ordinance amending the Solid Waste Capital Reserve Fund
